## Janssen Way Lesson Plan

Universal Expectations: Be respectful and responsible in the bathroom

Skill/Setting: Bathroom Grade level 4K-4

## PURPOSE OF LESSON (Define): (Why is this important?)

To demonstrate appropriate bathroom behaviors.

"Today we are going to talk about how we are respectful and responsible in the bathroom."

"Boys (or girls) can someone tell me what we are going to be learning today?"

## **TEACHING AND EXAMPLES (Model):**

Talk through expectations on matrix \ poster (show poster)

Model walking feet to the stall, flush, voices off

\*\*Example of what to say while modeling - "boys and girls notice how my feet are quiet as i walk to the stall. Once i am in i would close the door and lock it however i am not going to do that right now so you can see me. When i am all finished it is important to flush so the toilet is empty. If a friend whispers to me in the bathroom, i need to remind my friend that voices should be off. When i am all done, i am going to go to the sink to start the five twos." Model 5 twos using visual\poster (read poster as you model the steps)

**STUDENT ACTIVITIES (Practice): (student modeling and role play/multi-modal activities, etc)** Line students up outside, have 3 to 5 students go in at a time to demonstrate walking feet, flushing, voices off, and 5 twos

## FOLLOW UP/REINFORCEMENT ACTIVITIES: (Re-teach, Model, Practice, Acknowledge)

- \*practice weekly
- \*use 5 twos in the classroom
- \*possible video boosters
